

- bibliocommons (ppl)


Local Catalog - 583



Local Catalog - 583 w/ javascript




Local Catalog - Webpac - 856



My current opinions:

Local catalogs: must have 583, display encouraged but optional (and contingent on catalog)

Central System: screen scrape or API from OCLC until III can handle 583 (if ever).

(quick poll of catalogers was 2 to 1 against using 856 in non standard way)

Local III Catalog options:

- Configure webpub.def to display 583
 - Ugly display
- Configure webpub.def to display 583 and use javascript to clean up display
 - yet another 'hack' that might break in upgrades, etc.
- . Use item 856 only field that will transfer to Innreach, but a rather non standard use.
